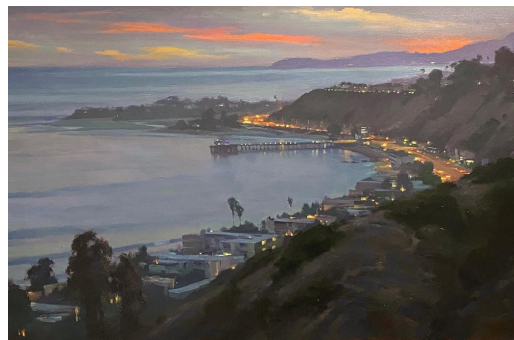
Fredrick R. Weisman Museum of Art at Pepperdine University

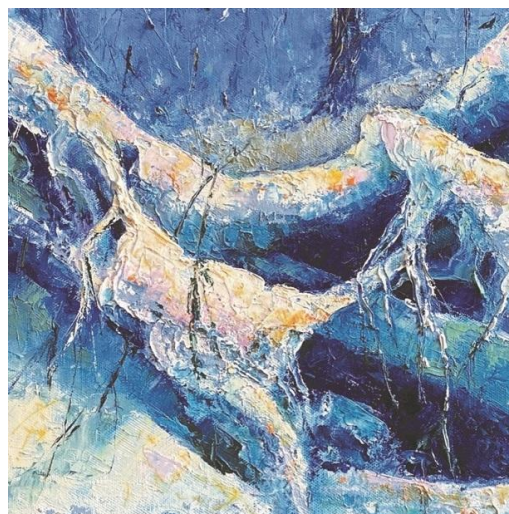
Chapter Exhibition: Greater Sacramento Sierra and San Francisco Bay Area

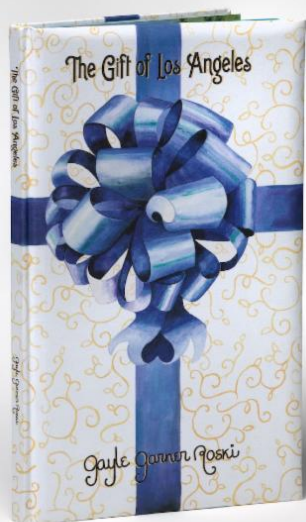
